



Summer Mission Trip 2022

When: July 17-23, 2022

Where: Romney, WV

What: Work Camp with the Jeremiah Project!

This trip will have a focus on home repair and construction work (wheel chair ramps, painting, minor home repairs, yard work, etc.) for those in need. Find out more information about Jeremiah Project at www.jeremiahproject.org!

Who: Current 6th-12th grade students.

This trip is for both middle and high school students. However, the work teams will be made up of all middle school or all high school students in order to offer age appropriate experiences.

Currently, we have space for 19 youth to go on the trip. If more than 19 youth would like to go, they will be put on a wait list. Once we have secured enough adults and vehicles, if there is space at the camp, they will be added to the team.

In order to sign up for the trip, two items are needed:

- 1- Mission Team Commitment Form
- 2- \$150 deposit

A youth will not be signed up for the trip until the forms and a deposit have been turned in!

Cost:

The cost of the trip that each family is responsible for is \$300 per youth*. (Scholarships are available) We will be fundraising as a youth group to raise the balance of the trip cost. (Failure to participate in fundraisers will increase your individual cost.)

A deposit of \$150 is due with the mission team commitment form

Final balance of \$150 is due no later than May 1, 2022

Because of the payment timeline for this trip, any person who cancels after Feb 28, 2022 will still be responsible for the full cost of the trip.

Dates:

Feb 2- Registration and deposit of \$150 due.

May 1- Final balance of \$150 due

May 25-Team Training 4-6pm

July 19- Leave for Romney, WV 9am (meet at church)

July 23- Return from Romney, WV (3pm)

This is a big commitment, but it is an amazing opportunity for God to move in your student's life! So many positive things happen on mission trips, both for our team and for the people we serve. I believe that this trip will have a significant Kingdom impact for Jesus. I'm praying for you even as I write this!
