



Our Middle School mission trip in 2020 will be with Jeremiah Project in Romney, West Virginia.

The dates for Jeremiah Project are **July 19-25, 2020**. This trip will have a focus on home repair and construction work (wheel chair ramps, painting, minor home repairs, yard work, etc.) for those in need. Find out more information about Jeremiah Project at www.jeremiahproject.org!

This trip is open to current 6th-8th grade students.

Currently, we have space for 14 youth to go on the trip. Sign-ups for youth who are interested in serving on the team will be accepted beginning **Sunday, Nov 3, 2020**. If more than 14 youth would like to go, they will be put on a wait list. Once we have secured enough adults and vehicles, if there is space at the camp, they will be added to the team.

In order to sign up for the trip, two items are needed:

1- Mission Team Commitment Form

2- \$100 deposit

A youth will not be signed up for the trip until BOTH the forms and a deposit have been turned in!

Cost:

The cost of the trip that each family is responsible for is \$300 per youth*. (Scholarships are available) We will be fundraising as a youth group to raise the balance of the trip cost. (Failure to participate in fundraisers will increase your individual cost.)

A deposit of \$100 is due with the mission team commitment form

A 2nd deposit of \$100 is due by **Sunday January 26, 2020**

A final balance of \$100 is due by **Sunday May 3, 2020**

*Of the \$300, *at least* \$100 should be raised by the individual youth participating in the trip. This helps give ownership to the trip!

Because of the payment timeline set by Jeremiah Project, any person who cancels after Feb 1, 2020 will still be responsible for the **full cost** of the trip.

Dates:**

Dec 15, 2020- Commitment form and 1st deposit of \$100 due

Jan 26- Second payment of \$100 due

April 26th- Sponsorship Sunday (please be at one or both services-preferably both!)

May 3rd- Final balance of \$100 due

May 9th- Fundraiser work day 9am- 3pm

May 20th- Team Training 4-6pm

May 31st- Team Training- 12:30-2:30pm

July 19- Leave for Romney, WV 9am (meet at church)

July 25- Return from Romney, WV (4pm)

**an additional fundraiser may be added, but I will give you advanced notice!

This is a big commitment, but it is an amazing opportunity for God to move in your student's life! So many positive things happen on mission trips, both for our team and for the people we serve. I believe that this trip will have a significant Kingdom impact for Jesus. I'm praying for you even as I write this!

Of this \$300, at least \$100 will be raised solely by the youth.
